#### From the Pastor's Desk...

#### **SEPTEMBER 2015**

Dear Cup Family and Friends,

Fall is upon us, with all of the excitement and opportunity that getting back to school brings. All of the programming such as football, soccer, dance, scouting, (and Shine of course!) scramble to fill up our touch-screen calendars, leaving many of us to breathe a huge sigh of relief on Sunday morning. . . .but is it really worth it to 'sleep in' on the Sabbath?

This Fall we're taking a journey on that roller-coaster, kaleidoscope, grand finale of a book called 'REVELATION.' I want to give you four reasons from John's visionary writing on WHY WE NEED CORPORATE WORSHIP IN OUR LIVES, NO MATTER HOW YOUNG OR OLD WE ARE:

First, *We Need Praise*. God has created us as worshipping people. We will give our hearts and minds to something that we consider to be greater than ourselves. Shopping channels, food brands, political parties, sports teams, friend cliques – they all try to pull us into saying with our time, our money, and devotion – 'YOU'RE NUMBER 1!' But John shows us by entering the throne room of heaven (Chapter 4 of Revelation) that no one and nothing can compare with the majesty, glory and worthiness of God, our creator. No stadium, audience, or activity can compare with this!

Next, *We Need Perspective.* In John's day, Christians were a small minority, frequently misunderstood, marginalized, and even martyred. The Roman Empire called on everyone to worship Caesar as god, and to trust the power of the sword and the maxim, 'Might makes right.' The power and rage of political power that seeks only its own glory is frightening and distracting. Yet Revelation shows us over and over again that God is in charge, and the Lion who is also a Lamb holds the real key to our destiny. (Ch. 5) If we don't take time to hear preaching and teaching that reminds us of this, our heads, hearts, and priorities will be turned upside down, and it will destroy us (3:14-20, ch. 13)

Third, *We Need People of Faith*. One of the ways we can look at Revelation is as a set of nesting dolls – one step leads directly to the next, and the pieces won't fit unless we unlock them in order. The whole book begins with a vision of Jesus (1:9-20). We won't get anything else right unless we get Him right. Yet we can't get to the place of worship (Ch. 4-5) without first going through the church (Ch. 2-3). The Bible doesn't recognize individual, 'free agent' Christianity: we are baptized into family, and that family is the church. We have to help each other, because so many around us are fighting against the hope that we have without even knowing it. Corporate worship is as optional for the Christ-follower as oxygen.

Finally, *We Need Power*. There is too much chaos, brokenness, and pressure in the typical American's life to pretend that we can live hopeful, joyful lives without God, at long as we want to be in touch with reality. Jesus continually promises the churches facing incredible odds that if they keep looking to Him, they will receive not only what they *need*, but blessings dearer than their greatest desires. A crown of life (2:10). A blessed, brand-new name (2:17). The star of the morning (2:28). And, ultimately, the greatest wedding reception party the universe has ever seen (21:1-5, 22:1-4).

Friends, take the time to worship this Fall. Make it a priority. Bring your friends. You won't regret it.!



Children are encouraged to attend. We are only asking for \$15. to cover their meals.


