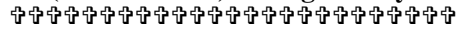
CHURCH OFFICE HOURS

The Church Office will be open for in-person business

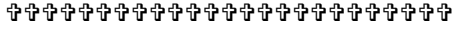

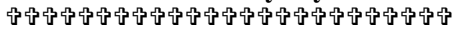
The CUP Deacons are collecting again for the CUP Food Pantry. Each month we will have a different food collection "theme".

JULY = Condiments

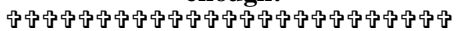
AUG = Starches (rice, boxed potatoes, noodles)



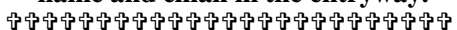

VBS Twists and Turns was a huge success! The volunteers were amazing! We can't THANK YOU enough!

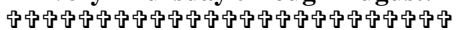

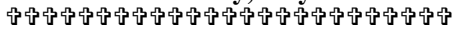
